House Resolution 1 2 A resolution proclaiming September 2002 as Take Your Dad to School Month in Florida. 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Education published a study in 1998 entitled "Fathers' Involvement in б 7 Their Children's Schools," which revealed that children whose fathers participate in their school activities, as compared to 8 their peers whose fathers do not, are more likely to have 9 higher test scores, better academic and attendance records, 10 11 and fewer behavior problems, and 12 WHEREAS, children who have the benefit of two 13 supportive parents, even if their parents are separated, are 14 less likely to live in poverty, are less likely to drop out of 15 school, are less likely to become involved in delinquent 16 behavior, are at lower risk for teen pregnancy, and are less likely to become involved in an abusive relationship, and 17 WHEREAS, children who have the benefit of a healthy, 18 19 active relationship with their fathers are more likely to be well-adjusted in adolescence and adulthood, and 20 21 WHEREAS, fathers are increasingly being encouraged by 22 all segments of society to take an active part in their 23 children's activities, and 24 WHEREAS, children whose fathers are not present benefit from a relationship with nurturing and actively involved 25 father figures, such as grandfathers, uncles, Big Brothers, 26 27 and mentors, and such men are increasingly taking an active 28 role in the lives of children whose biological fathers are 29 absent, and 30 31 1
