WHEREAS, through his dedication, integrity, discipline, and perseverance, Brian Shimer embodies the true Olympic Spirit, and

WHEREAS, he was bestowed by his United States Olympic teammates the honor of carrying the American flag at the closing ceremonies of the 2002 Winter Games, and

WHEREAS, Brian Shimer has become a true sporting hero to all Naples and Collier County residents, to all Floridians, and to all Americans, NOW, THEREFORE,
