**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 15, between lines 30 and 31,

insert:

Section 3. The Secretary of Children and Family Services shall establish a workgroup for the purposes of reviewing issues associated with services and supports provided through state-funded supportive housing and developing legislative recommendations for state-funded supportive housing living arrangements. The workgroup shall address development of administrative rules regarding:

- (1) The definition of supportive housing services;
- (2) Consumer health and safety; and
- (3) The use of subsidies funded by the Department of Children and Family Services.

The Secretary of Children and Family Services shall ensure that representatives participate in the workgroup from the department and from the Agency for Health Care Administration,
