10	Section 1. Section 316.121, Florida Statutes, is
11	amended to read:
12	316.121 Vehicles approaching or entering

14	(1) The driver of a vehicle approaching an
15	intersection shall yield the right-of-way to a vehicle which
16	has entered the intersection from a different highway.
17	(2) When two vehicles enter an intersection from
18	different highways at the same time the driver of the vehicle
19	on the left shall yield the right-of-way to the vehicle on the
20	right.
21	(3) The driver of a vehicle about to enter or cross a
22	state-maintained road or highway from a paved or unpaved road
23	and not subject to control by an official traffic control
24	device shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles
25	approaching on the state-maintained road or highway.
26	(4) The driver of a vehicle about to enter or cross a
27	paved county-maintained road or highway from a nonmaintained
28	paved or unpaved road and not subject to control by an
29	official traffic control device shall yield the right-of-way
30	to all vehicles approaching on the county-maintained road or
31	highway.

(5) (4) The driver of a vehicle about to enter or cross a paved county-maintained or city-maintained road or highway from an unpaved road or highway and not subject to control by an official traffic control device shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles approaching on said paved road or highway. (6) The foregoing rules are modified at through highways and otherwise, as hereinafter stated. (7) A violation of this section is a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a moving violation as provided in chapter 318. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY Provides that the driver of a vehicle about to enter or cross a paved county-maintained road or highway from a nonmaintained paved or unpaved road not subject to control by an official traffic control device must yield the right-of-way to all vehicles approaching on the county-maintained road or highway.
