Public Employee Optional Retirement Program.

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Section 3. This act shall take effect June 1, 2002. HOUSE SUMMARY Exempts all records which identify individual participants in the Florida Retirement System and their account activities under the Public Employee Optional Retirement Program from the public records law to the extent such records need not be revealed in the administration of the Florida Retirement System or in connection with a legal or administrative proceeding.
