Section 1. Intent.--Pursuant to section 191.015, Florida Statutes, it is the intent of the Legislature to provide a single, comprehensive special act charter for the Cedar Hammock Fire Control District, which includes all current legislative authority granted to the district by its several legislative enactments and any additional authority granted by this act and chapters 189 and 191, Florida Statutes, as they may be amended from time to time. The Cedar Hammock Fire Control District's charter was codified in chapter 2000-391, Laws of Florida. It is intended that this act be the District's single comprehensive special act. It is further the intent of this act to preserve all district authority.
