Section 812.0145, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 11 12 812.0145 Theft from persons 65 years of age or older; reclassification of offenses.--13 (1) A person who is convicted of theft of more than 14 15 \$1,000 from a person 65 years of age or older shall be ordered by the sentencing judge to make restitution to the victim of 16 17 such offense and to perform up to 500 hours of community service work. Restitution and community service work shall be 18 19 in addition to any fine or sentence which may be imposed and 20 shall not be in lieu thereof. 21 (2) Whenever a person is charged with committing theft 22 from a person 65 years of age or older, regardless of whether he or she knows or has reason to know the age of the victim, 23 the offense for which the person is charged shall be 24 25 reclassified as follows: 26 (a) If the funds, assets, or property involved in the 27 theft from a person 65 years of age or older is valued at \$50,000 or more, the offender commits a felony of the first 28 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or 29 30 s. 775.084. 31
