L8	(3) The department shall identify those courses
L9	offered by universities and accepted for credit toward a
20	degree. The department shall identify courses designated as
21	either general education or required as a prerequisite for a
22	degree. The courses shall be identified by their statewide
23	course number.
24	(4) The boards of trustees of the community colleges
25	and state universities shall identify their core curricula.
26	The universities and community colleges shall work with their
27	school districts to assure that high school curricula
28	coordinate with the core curricula and to prepare students for
29	college-level work. Core curricula for associate in arts
30	programs shall be adopted in rule by the State Board of
31	Education and shall include 36 semester hours of general

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education courses in the subject areas of communication, mathematics, social sciences, humanities, and natural sciences.

- (5) An associate in arts degree shall require no more than 60 semester hours of college credit, including 36 semester hours of general education coursework. Except for college-preparatory coursework required pursuant to s.

 1008.30, all required coursework shall count toward the associate in arts degree or the baccalaureate degree.
- (6) A baccalaureate degree program shall require no more than 120 semester hours of college credit, including 36 semester hours of general education coursework, unless prior approval has been granted by the State Board of Education.
- (7) A student who received an associate in arts degree for successfully completing 60 semester credit hours may continue to earn additional credits at a community college. The university must provide credit toward the student's baccalaureate degree for an additional community college course if, according to the statewide course numbering, the community college course is a course listed in the university catalog as required for the degree or as prerequisite to a course required for the degree. Of the courses required for the degree shall be achievable through courses designated as lower division, except in degree programs approved by the State Board of Education.
- (8) Students at state universities may request associate in arts certificates if they have successfully completed the minimum requirements for the degree of associate in arts (A.A.). The university must grant the student an associate in arts degree if the student has successfully

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completed minimum requirements for college-level communication and computation skills adopted by the State Board of Education 2 3 and 60 academic semester hours or the equivalent within a 4 degree program area, with 36 semester hours in general education courses in the subject areas of communication, 5 mathematics, social sciences, humanities, and natural sciences, consistent with the general education requirements specified in the articulation agreement pursuant to s. 8 9 1007.23. (9) The Commissioner of Education shall appoint 10 faculty committees representing both community college and 11 12 public school faculties to recommend to the commissioner for 13 approval by the State Board of Education a standard program 14 length and appropriate occupational completion points for each 15 postsecondary career and technical certificate program, 16 diploma, and degree. 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 29 30

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
