Section 1072. Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 110.1099, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

110.1099 Education and training opportunities for state employees.--

(1)(a) Education and training are an integral component in improving the delivery of services to the public. Recognizing that the application of productivity-enhancing technology and practice demands continuous educational and training opportunities, a state employee may be authorized to receive a voucher or grant, for matriculation fees, to attend work-related courses at public community colleges, public technical centers, or public universities. ~~Student credit hours generated by state employee fee waivers shall be fundable credit hours.~~ The department may implement the provisions of this section from funds appropriated to the
