WHEREAS, this unique, interactive habitat, featuring an educational research laboratory, a museum, and botanical gardens, showcases the world's most beautiful tropical plants and is the largest center of its kind in the world, and

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek and Butterfly World are partners in promoting an active interest in the environment and in the beauty of the natural world in which we live, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That the City of Coconut Creek is hereby recognized as home to the largest butterfly habitat in the world.
