13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 14 15 Section 1. For purposes of chapter 220, Florida 16 17 Statutes, it is the intent of the Legislature by this section to adopt the Job Creation and Worker Assistance Act of 2002, 18 19 Pub. L. No. 107-147, and make those provisions effective for 20 purposes of chapter 220, Florida Statutes, to the extent that 21 such provisions are taken into account in the computation of 22 net income subject to tax therein.

23 Section 2. Paragraph (n) of subsection (1) and 24 paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 220.03, Florida 25 Statutes, are amended to read:

220.03 Definitions.--

(1) SPECIFIC TERMS.--When used in this code, and when not otherwise distinctly expressed or manifestly incompatible with the intent thereof, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

18	effect should be given to each if that is possible.
19	Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
20	law and the amendments to section $220.03(1)(n)$ and $(2)(c)$,
21	Florida Statutes, apply retroactively to January 1, 2002.
