of 1970, 21 U.S.C. s. 811.

(b) The substance's actual or relative potential for  
abuse as defined in chapter 893, Florida Statutes.

(c) Scientific evidence of the substance's  
pharmacological effect, if known.

(d) The state of current scientific knowledge  
regarding the substance.

(e) The substance's history and current pattern of  
abuse.
