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15	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
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17	Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section
18	210.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

21	(2) As collections are received by the division from
22	such cigarette taxes, it shall pay the same into a trust fund
23	in the State Treasury designated "Cigarette Tax Collection
24	Trust Fund" which shall be paid and distributed as follows:
25	(b) $1$ . Beginning January 1, 1999, and continuing for 10
26	years thereafter, the division shall from month to month
27	certify to the Comptroller the amount derived from the
28	cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges
29	provided for in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount

30 derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02 which 31 shall be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco

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Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 2.59 percent of the net collections, and that amount shall be paid to the Board of 3 Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, established under s. 240.512, by warrant drawn by 4 5 the Comptroller upon the State Treasury. These funds are 6 hereby appropriated monthly out of the Cigarette Tax 7 Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the purpose of constructing, furnishing, and equipping a cancer research 8 9 facility at the University of South Florida adjacent to the H. 10 Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute. In fiscal 11 years 1999-2000 and thereafter with the exception of fiscal year 2008-2009, the appropriation to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer 12 13 Center and Research Institute authorized by this subparagraph 14 paragraph shall not be less than the amount that which would 15 have been paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute for fiscal year 1998-1999 had payments been 16 17 made for the entire fiscal year rather than for a 6-month period thereof. 18

2. Beginning July 1, 2002, and continuing through June 30, 2004, the division shall, in addition to the distribution authorized in subparagraph 1., from month to month certify to the Comptroller the amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges provided in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, which shall be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 0.2632 percent of the net collections, and that amount shall be paid to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, established under s. 240.512, by warrant drawn by the Comptroller.

Beginning July 1, 2004, and continuing through June 30, 2016,

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the division shall, in addition to the distribution authorized
    in subparagraph 1., from month to month certify to the
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    Comptroller the amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed
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    by s. 210.02, less the service charges provided in s. 215.20
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    and less 0.9 percent of the amount derived from the cigarette
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    tax imposed by s. 210.02, which shall be deposited into the
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    Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an
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    amount equal to 1.47 percent of the net collections, and that
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    amount shall be paid to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee
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    Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, established
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    under s. 240.512, by warrant drawn by the Comptroller. These
    funds are appropriated monthly out of the Cigarette Tax
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    Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the purpose of
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    constructing, furnishing, and equipping a cancer research
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    facility at the University of South Florida adjacent to the H.
    Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute. In fiscal
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    year 2004-2005 and thereafter, the appropriation to the H. Lee
    Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute authorized by
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    this subparagraph shall not be less than the amount that would
    have been paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and
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    Research Institute in fiscal year 2001-2002 if this
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    subparagraph had been in effect.
           Section 2. Section 210.201, Florida Statutes, is
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    amended to read:
           210.201 Cancer research facility at the University of
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    South Florida; establishment; funding. -- The Board of Directors
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    of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute
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    shall construct, furnish, and equip, and shall covenant to
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    complete, the cancer research facility at the University of
    South Florida adjacent to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and
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31 Research Institute. Moneys transferred to the Board of
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Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute <u>pursuant to s. 210.20</u> shall be used to secure financing to pay costs related to constructing, furnishing, and equipping the cancer research facility. Such financing may include the issuance of tax exempt bonds by a local authority, municipality, or county pursuant to parts II and III of chapter 159. Such bonds shall not constitute state bonds for purposes of s. 11, Art. VII of the State Constitution, but shall constitute bonds of a "local agency," as defined in s. 159.27(4). The cigarette tax dollars pledged to this facility <u>pursuant to s. 210.20 may shall</u> be replaced annually by the Legislature from tobacco litigation settlement proceeds.

Section 3. If any law that is amended by this act was also amended by a law enacted at the 2002 Regular Session of the Legislature, such laws shall be construed as if they had been enacted at the same session of the Legislature, and full effect should be given to each if that is possible.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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## Provides for a portion of the revenues from the cigarette tax to be paid monthly to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, to finance a cancer research facility at the University of South Florida. Provides for the use of the transferred moneys.
