Morris. 3 4 WHEREAS, while covering the Legislature in 1941 for the 5 Miami Herald, Allen Morris developed a fascination for the workings and people of Florida government, and 6 7 WHEREAS, in 1947 and biennially thereafter, he published The Florida Handbook, the comprehensive and 8 9 acknowledged authority on Florida history, commerce, and 10 government, and 11 WHEREAS, while a freelance journalist, Allen Morris wrote the syndicated "Cracker Politics" column, through which 12 he provided an astute and sweeping chronicle of Florida 13 14 political history from 1943-1966, and 15 WHEREAS, while still a journalist, Allen Morris became 16 a consultant on the Rules of the House of Representatives and often noted that it was through respect for the Rules that we 17 demonstrate respect for the institution itself, and 18 19 WHEREAS, Allen Morris was elected by the Members of the 20 House of Representatives as Clerk in 1966, responsible for recording sessions and providing parliamentary counsel, and 21 22 was subsequently elected and held office for 10 terms and 77 sessions, and 23 24 WHEREAS, Allen Morris served as Clerk Emeritus while continuing his historical writings from 1986 to 1993, and 25 26 WHEREAS, in thought, temperament, and consideration for 27 others, Allen Morris represented all that is good and worthy about this great institution of which we are a part, and 28 29 WHEREAS, Allen C. Morris, beloved teacher, counselor, 30 and friend to this Chamber and to generations of Florida 31
