House Resolution

A resolution requesting the United States Senate vote to make permanent the tax relief in the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001.

WHEREAS, H.R. 1836, the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001, was passed with bipartisan support, and

WHEREAS, the bill granted much-needed tax relief for all working families in Florida, and

WHEREAS, due to a clause in the act, the tax cuts expire in the year 2010, and

WHEREAS, if the tax relief in H.R. 1836 is not made permanent, it will, in the first year alone, amount to a sudden and significant tax increase for middle-income American families, and

WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives voted to make the tax cuts permanent by a vote of 229-198, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That the House of Representatives of the State of Florida expresses its will that our representatives in the United States Senate support, work to pass, and vote in favor of a bill to make permanent the tax relief in H.R. 1836, the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001.
