STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR Senate Bill 1044 The committee substitute rewrites the bill and amends s. 373.116, F.S., to provide that notice for certain water permits may be sent by regular mail or electronic mail. All permits for consumptive water use, dam and reservoir construction, and dredge and fill activities for stormwater management systems must contain certain specified language.
