collected, which the clerk shall retain as a service charge, to the State Treasury for deposit into the Child Advocacy 2 3 Trust Fund for disbursement to the Florida Network of 4 Children's Advocacy Centers, Inc., for the purpose of funding 5 children's advocacy centers that are members of the network. 6 (3) At the end of each fiscal year each children's 7 advocacy center receiving revenue from the Child Advocacy Trust Fund must provide a report to the Board of Directors of 8 9 the Florida Network of Children's Advocacy Centers, Inc., 10 which reflects center expenditures, all sources of revenue received, and outputs that have been standardized and agreed 11 upon by network members and the board of directors, such as 12 the number of clients served, client demographic information, 13 14 and number and types of services provided.
