A bill to be entitled

An act relating to participation in insurance plans; amending ss. 255.05 and 287.057, F.S.; prohibiting the requirement that contractors or subcontractors under certain contracts participate in, or be penalized for nonparticipation in, certain insurance plans; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (10) is added to section 255.05, Florida Statutes, to read:

255.05 Bond of contractor constructing public buildings; form; action by materialmen.--

(10) A party to a contract to which this section applies may not require a contractor or a subcontractor to participate in, and a party may not be penalized for not participating in, an insurance plan controlled by an owner or contractor under which plan an owner or contractor, or an agent of the owner or contractor, obtains insurance coverage for contractors and subcontractors relating to a project or group of related projects, including, but not limited to, workers' compensation, employer's liability, general liability, or builder's risk insurance.

Section 2. Subsection (25) is added to section 287.057, Florida Statutes, to read:

287.057 Procurement of commodities or contractual services.--

(25) A party to a contract to which this section applies may not require a contractor or a subcontractor to participate



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in, and a party may not be penalized for not participating in, an insurance plan controlled by an owner or contractor under which plan an owner or contractor, or an agent of the owner or contractor, obtains insurance coverage for contractors and subcontractors relating to a project or group of related projects, including, but not limited to, workers' compensation, employer's liability, general liability, or builder's risk insurance.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
