SECTION 2. Basic rights. -- All natural persons, female and male alike, are equal before the law and have inalienable rights, among which are the right to enjoy and defend life and liberty, to pursue happiness, to be rewarded for industry, and

to acquire, possess and protect property; except that the ownership, inheritance, disposition and possession of real property by aliens ineligible for citizenship may be regulated or prohibited by law. No person shall be deprived of any right because of race, religion, national origin, or physical disability, or mental disability, as the terms "physical disability" and "mental disability" may be defined by general law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the title and substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on the ballot as follows:

BASIC RIGHTS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Proposes an amendment to Section 2 of Article I of the State Constitution to prohibit depriving a person of any right because of physical or mental disability, as the terms "physical disability" and "mental disability" may be defined by general law.
