Senator Wasserman Schultz moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 132, line 8, through,
page 133, line 17, delete those lines

and insert:

3. All impairment income benefits shall be based on an impairment rating using the impairment schedule referred to in subparagraph 2. For accidents occurring after July 1994 and before July 1, 2003, impairment income benefits are paid weekly at the rate of 100 ~~50~~ percent of the employee's average weekly temporary total disability benefit not to exceed the maximum weekly benefit under s. 440.12. An employee's entitlement to impairment income benefits begins the day after the employee reaches maximum medical improvement or the expiration of temporary benefits, whichever occurs earlier, and continues until the earlier of:

- a. The expiration of a period computed at the rate of 3 weeks for each percentage point of impairment; or
- b. The death of the employee.
