**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, lines 13-21, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 11 of chapter 2000-312, Laws of Florida, subsection (7) of section 125.0104, Florida Statutes, shall not stand repealed on October 1, 2005, as scheduled by such law, but that subsection, as amended by section 14 of chapter 2001-252, Laws of Florida, is revived and reenacted, and paragraph (b) of subsection (5) of that section is amended to read:

125.0104 Tourist development tax; procedure for levying; authorized uses; referendum; enforcement.--

(5) AUTHORIZED USES OF REVENUE.--

(b) Tax revenues received pursuant to this section by a county of less than 750,000 ~~600,000~~ population imposing a tourist development tax may only be used by that county for the following purposes in addition to those purposes allowed pursuant to paragraph (a): to acquire, construct, extend,

 2 promote one or more zoological parks, fishing piers or nature

 6 shall be based on the most recent population estimates  
 7 prepared pursuant to the provisions of s. 186.901. These
