Section 9. Subsection (11) is added to Section 760.02,
Florida Statutes, to read:

760.02 Definitions.--For the purposes of ss. 760.01-760.11
and 509.092, the term:

(11) "Public accommodations" means places of public
accommodation, lodgings, facilities principally engaged in
selling food for consumption on the premises, gasoline stations,
places of exhibition or entertainment, and other covered
establishments. Each of the following establishments which
serves the public is a place of public accommodation within the
meaning of this section:

27 (a) Any inn, hotel, motel, or other establishment which
28 provides lodging to transient guests, other than an
29 establishment located within a building which contains not more
30 than four rooms for rent or hire and which is actually occupied
31 by the proprietor of such establishment as his or her residence.

32 (b) Any restaurant, cafeteria, lunchroom, lunch counter,
33 soda fountain, or other facility principally engaged in selling
34 food for consumption on the premises, including, but not limited
35 to, any such facility located on the premises of any retail
36 establishment, or any gasoline station.

37 (c) Any motion picture house, theater, concert hall,
38 sports arena, stadium, or other place of exhibition or
39 entertainment.

40 (d) Any establishment which is physically located within
41 the premises of any establishment otherwise covered by this
42 subsection, or within the premises of which is physically
43 located any such covered establishment, and which holds itself
44 out as serving patrons of such covered establishment.

45 Section 10. Section 760.08, Florida Statutes, is created
46 to read:

47 760.08 Discrimination in places of public accommodation.--
48 All persons shall be entitled to the full and equal enjoyment of
49 the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages, and
50 accommodations of any place of public accommodation, as defined
51 in this chapter, without discrimination or segregation on the
52 ground of race, color, national origin, sex, handicap, familial
53 status, or religion.
