17	Section 1. <u>Notwithstanding the provisions of section</u>		
18	<u>1006.37, Florida Statutes, the Department of Education may</u>		
19	<u>conduct a pilot program to enable selected school districts to</u>		
20	<u>realize cost savings without loss of quality or availability</u>		
21	<u>for individual students in the purchase of used instructional</u>		
22	<u>materials. The school districts of Hernando County, Pasco</u>		
23	<u>County, and Polk County may participate in the pilot program.</u>		
24	<u>Charter schools in such school districts shall be eligible to</u>		
25	<u>participate in the pilot program. When a secondhand book</u>		
26	<u>dealer or other third-party book vendor provides used adopted</u>		
27	<u>instructional materials to a school district, the dealer or</u>		
28	<u>vendor must certify the availability of the used instructional</u>		
29	<u>materials, provide the International Standard Book Number of</u>

1 most currently adopted, Florida-specific instructional
2 materials, and that the materials conform to the Sunshine
3 State Standards. The state is not responsible for financial
4 loss caused by the school district's deviating from the
5 requirements of section 1006.37, Florida Statutes. The Council
6 for Education Policy Research and Improvement shall submit to
7 the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
8 Representatives for consideration during the 2004 Regular
9 Session a report of the cost savings to school districts based
10 on results of the pilot program. This section is repealed July
11 1, 2006.
