10	Section 1. (1) The Department of Law Enforcement shall
11	conduct a study regarding the establishment of minimum standards
12	for latent fingerprint examiners. The study shall:
13	(a) Examine currently available training for latent
14	fingerprint examiners;
15	(b) Determine which training providers offer training and
16	instruction that meets or exceeds the standards established by
17	the American Society of Crime Laboratory Directors Laboratory
18	Accreditation Board (ASCLD-LAB); and
19	(c) Determine whether such training can best be provided
20	through the department or through a law enforcement agency other
21	than the department.
22	(2) The department shall provide a written report of its
23	findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of
24	the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by
25	<u>July 1, 2004.</u>
26	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
