A bill to be entitled

An act calling a special election for the approval or rejection by the electors of a joint resolution relating to the repeal of provisions that mandate maximum class sizes for students in prekindergarten through grade 12.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Under Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution, there shall be a special election on November 4, 2003, at which there shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection Senate Joint Resolution No. ____, relating to the repeal of provisions that prescribe the maximum class sizes allowed for students in prekindergarten through grade 12.

Section 2. Publication of notice shall be in accordance with Section 5 of Article XI of the State Constitution. The special election shall be held as other special elections are held.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, but only if it is enacted by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides for a special election to be conducted on November 4, 2003, to submit to the electors a proposed constitutional revision that repeals provisions prescribing the maximum allowable class size for kindergarten through grade 12.
