If the county is not participating in such a 22 program, funds collected must be used to fund local law enforcement automation and must be distributed to the 23 municipality or special improvement district in which the 24 25 violation occurred or to the county if the violation occurred 26 within the unincorporated area of the county. If a 27 municipality within the county maintains an independent 800 28 megahertz radio communication program that can communicate 29 with the county's system or if the mutual-aid channels are 30 compatible, funds collected from violations that occur within the territorial jurisdiction of that municipality must be used 31 1
