This section does not eliminate the equitable 21 22 rights of any party, and may only be invoked by a party in direct privity of contract with the unlicensed contractor or 23 by a payment bond surety against whom an unlicensed contractor 24 25 has asserted a claim. Payment bond rights do not exist in 26 favor of any contractor who does not obtain or maintain 27 licensure. A contract rendered unenforceable by this section 28 does not render unenforceable any other contract or the obligations of a surety who has provided a bond on behalf of 29 30 the unlicensed contractor. This section does not apply to any 31
