(15) APPLICABILITY TO COUNTIES, COUNTY OFFICERS,
DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARDS, AND SPECIAL DISTRICTS.--

(a) Rates that exceed the maximum travel reimbursement
rates for nonstate travelers specified in s. 112.061(6)(a) for
per diem, in s. 112.061(6)(b) for subsistence, and in s.
112.061(7)(d)1. for mileage may be established by:

1. The governing body of a county by the enactment of
an ordinance or resolution;

2. A county constitutional officer, pursuant to
Article VIII, s.1.(d) of the State Constitution, by the
establishment of written policy;

3. The governing body of a district school board by
the adoption of rules; or

4. The governing body of a special district, as
defined in s. 189.403(1), except those special districts that

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1 are subject to s. 166.021(10), by the enactment of a
2 resolution.

3 (b) Rates established pursuant to paragraph (15)(a)
4 must apply uniformly to all travel by the county, county
5 constitutional officer and entity governed by that officer,
6 district school board, or special district.

7 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
8 counties, county constitutional officers and entities governed
9 by those officers, district school boards, and special
10 districts, other than those subject to s. 166.021(10), remain
11 subject to the requirements of this section.
