Between line(s) 4781 and 4782, insert:

Section 71. Subsection (1) of section 1006.28, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1006.28 Duties of district school board, district school superintendent; and school principal regarding K-12 instructional materials.--

(1) DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD.--The district school board has the duty to provide adequate instructional materials for all students enrolled in the public school system only, including dual enrolled students pursuant to s. 1007.271, in accordance with the requirements of this part. The term "adequate instructional materials" means a sufficient number of textbooks or sets of materials serving as the basis for instruction for each student in the core courses of mathematics, language arts,

28 social studies, science, reading, and literature, except for  
29 instruction for which the school advisory council approves the  
30 use of a program that does not include a textbook as a major  
31 tool of instruction. The district school board has the following  
32 specific duties:

33 (a) *Courses of study; adoption.*--Adopt courses of study  
34 for use in the schools of the district.

35 (b) *Textbooks.*--Provide for proper requisitioning,  
36 distribution, accounting, storage, care, and use of all  
37 instructional materials furnished by the state and furnish such  
38 other instructional materials as may be needed. The district  
39 school board shall assure that instructional materials used in  
40 the district are consistent with the district goals and  
41 objectives and the curriculum frameworks adopted by rule of the  
42 State Board of Education, as well as with the state and district  
43 performance standards provided for in s. 1001.03(1).

44 (c) *Other instructional materials.*--Provide such other  
45 teaching accessories and aids as are needed for the school  
46 district's educational program.

47 (d) *School library media services; establishment and*  
48 *maintenance.*--Establish and maintain a program of school library  
49 media services for all public schools in the district, including  
50 school library media centers, or school library media centers  
51 open to the public, and, in addition such traveling or  
52 circulating libraries as may be needed for the proper operation  
53 of the district school system.

54 Section 72. The Office of Program Policy Analysis and  
55 Government Accountability shall review the John M. McKay  
56 Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program, pursuant to
