The Committee on Finance & Tax recommends the following:

An act relating to stamping of cigarettes in interstate commerce; amending s. 210.06, F.S.; requiring a wholesale dealer or distributing agent who transports or causes to be transported from this state cigarettes for sale in another state to affix to the cigarettes stamps required by the other state or to pay certain excise taxes; requiring reporting of transported cigarettes to the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation;

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (5), (6), (7), and (8) are added to section 210.06, Florida Statutes, to read:

(5) A wholesale dealer or distributing agent may not transport or cause to be transported from this state cigarettes for sale in another state without first affixing to the cigarettes the stamp required by the state in which the cigarettes are to be sold or paying any other excise tax on the cigarettes which is imposed by the state in which the cigarettes are to be sold.

- (6) A wholesale dealer or distributing agent may not affix to cigarettes the stamp required by another state or pay any other excise tax on the cigarettes which is imposed by another state if the other state prohibits stamps from being affixed to the cigarettes, prohibits the payment of any other excise tax on the cigarettes, or prohibits the sale of the cigarettes.
- (7) No later than the 10th day of each month, a wholesale dealer or distributing agent who has transported or caused to be transported from this state cigarettes for sale in another state shall submit to the division a report that identifies the quantity of each brand style of the cigarettes which has been transported or caused to be transported in the preceding calendar month and the name and address of each recipient of the cigarettes.
- (8) The division shall adopt rules necessary to administer subsections (5), (6), and (7).
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
