Section 2. Subsection (14) is added to section 112.061, Florida Statutes, to read:

112.061 Per diem and travel expenses of public officers, employees, and authorized persons.--

(14) APPLICABILITY TO COUNTIES, COUNTY OFFICERS, DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARDS, AND SPECIAL DISTRICTS.--

(a) Rates that exceed the maximum travel reimbursement rates for nonstate travelers specified in paragraph (6)(a) for per diem, in paragraph (6)(b) for subsistence, and in subparagraph (7)(d)1. for mileage may be established by:

1. The governing body of a county by the enactment of an ordinance or resolution;

27 2. A county constitutional officer, pursuant to s. 1(d),
28 Art. VIII of the State Constitution, by the establishment of
29 written policy;

30 3. The governing body of a district school board by the
31 adoption of rules; or

32 4. The governing body of a special district, as defined in
33 s. 189.403(1), except those special districts that are subject
34 to s. 166.021(10), by the enactment of a resolution.

35 (b) Rates established pursuant to paragraph (a) must apply
36 uniformly to all travel by the county, county constitutional
37 officer and the entity governed by that officer, district school
38 board, or special district.

39 (c) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
40 counties, county constitutional officers and entities governed
41 by those officers, district school boards, and special
42 districts, other than those subject to s. 166.021(10), remain
43 subject to the requirements of this section.

44 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law,
45 and the addition of subsection (10) to section 166.021, Florida
46 Statutes, by this act shall apply retroactively to January 1,
47 2003.
