Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 68.065, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

(3) Before recovery under this section subsection (1) may be claimed, a written demand <u>must shall</u> be delivered by certified or registered mail, evidenced by return receipt, <u>or by first-class mail</u>, evidenced by an affidavit of service by mail, to the maker or drawer of the check, draft, or order of payment to the address on the check or other instrument, to the address

given by the drawer at the time the instrument was issued, or to

28 the drawer's last known address. The form of such notice shall 29 be substantially as follows: 30 31 "You are hereby notified that a check numbered in 32 the face amount of \$\_\_\_\_ issued by you on ... (date) ... , 33 drawn upon ... (name of bank) ... , and payable to \_\_\_\_\_, has 34 been dishonored. Pursuant to Florida law, you have 30 days from 35 receipt of this notice to tender payment in cash of the full 36 amount of the check plus a service charge of \$25, if the face 37 value does not exceed \$50, \$30, if the face value exceeds \$50 38 but does not exceed \$300, \$40, if the face value exceeds \$300, 39 or 5 percent of the face amount of the check, whichever is 40 greater, the total amount due being \$ and cents. 41 Unless this amount is paid in full within the 30-day period, the 42 holder of the check or instrument may file a civil action against you for three times the amount of the check, but in no 43 44 case less than \$50, in addition to the payment of the check plus any court costs, reasonable attorney fees, and any bank fees 45 46 incurred by the payee in taking the action." 47 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003. 48 49
