Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

## Section 1. Child Advocacy Trust Fund .--

- (1) The Child Advocacy Trust Fund is created within the Department of Children and Family Services. The purpose of the trust fund is to receive funds pursuant to s. 938.10, Florida Statutes, which shall be disbursed in equal amounts to child advocacy centers that are members of the Florida Network of Children's Advocacy Centers, Inc., as established under s. 39.3035, Florida Statutes.
- (2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to s. 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.
- (3) Pursuant to s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State

  Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be

  terminated on July 1, 2007. Before its scheduled termination,

  the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1)

  and (2), Florida Statutes.
