

HB 1537 2003

A bill to be entitled

An act relating to public school personnel; creating s. 1012.235, F.S.; requiring the Department of Education to develop a policy that specifies the ratio of school social workers to students and the ratio of school psychologists to students to be maintained in the public schools; requiring reporting; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1012.235, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1012.235 School social workers and school psychologists.--

- (1) The Department of Education shall develop a policy that specifies the ratio of school social workers to students and the ratio of school psychologists to students that should be maintained in the public schools based on guidelines provided by the National Association of School Social Workers and the National Association of School Psychologists.
- (2) The policy shall include the rationale for employing school social workers and school psychologists in the public schools, a statement of the purpose of school social workers and school psychologists, a summary of the current ratios, and proposals to increase the number of school social workers and school psychologists to meet the specified ratios.
- (3) By January 2004, the department shall provide a copy of the policy to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
