Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003, and shall apply retroactively to January 1, 2003. Provides a credit against the corporate income tax or a sales tax rebate in the amount of \$1,500 per employee to a business that has fewer than 50 employees, that is located in either an enterprise zone or a rural area of critical economic concern, and that provides health insurance coverage to its employees. б
