A bill to be entitled
An act relating to independent living
transition services; amending s. 409.1451,
F.S.; providing that property acquired on
behalf of a client receiving independent living
transition services is the property of the
client; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Present subsection (8) of section 409.1451,
Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (9), and a new
subsection (8) is added to that section to read:

409.1451 Independent living transition services.--

(8) PROPERTY ACQUIRED ON BEHALF OF CLIENTS.--Property
acquired on behalf of a client receiving services under this
section shall be the personal property of the client and is
not subject to the requirements of chapter 273 relating to
state-owned tangible personal property.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that property acquired on behalf of a client
receiving independent living transition services is the
property of the client and is not subject to requirements
governing state-owned property.
