As a 36 condition of access to such information, the department shall be 37 required to execute an appropriate user agreement addressing the 38 access, use, dissemination, and destruction of such information 39 and to comply with all applicable laws and rules of the 40 41 Department of Law Enforcement. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
