A law enforcement agency must provide information to the department within 24 hours after any traffic fatality or when the law enforcement agency initiates action pursuant to s. 316.1933; Has been convicted of a violation of any traffic law (b) which resulted in a crash that caused the death or personal injury of another or property damage in excess of \$500; Is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle; (C) (d) Has permitted an unlawful or fraudulent use of such license or has knowingly been a party to the obtaining of a license by fraud or misrepresentation or to display, or represent as one's own, any driver's license not issued him or her. Provided, however, no provision of this section shall be construed to include the provisions of s. 322.32(1); Has committed an offense in another state which if (e) committed in this state would be grounds for suspension or revocation; or (f) Has committed a second or subsequent violation of s. 316.172(1) within a 5-year period of any previous violation.
