20	<u>delivery, except e-mail, to any person, including an elected</u>		
21	<u>or appointed officer or governmental employee, or to any state</u>		
22	<u>or local governmental entity. Nothing in this section applies</u>		
23	<u>to regulatory newsletters provided to affected persons or to</u>		
24	<u>reports or newsletters relating to the prevention or treatment</u>		
25	<u>of disease or injury.</u>		
26	<u>(b) Unsolicited agency e-mails authorized by this</u>		
27	<u>section must contain a provision that allows the recipient to</u>		
28	<u>be removed from future unsolicited agency e-mails upon his or</u>		
29	<u>her e-mail request.</u>
