25	<u>newsletters provided to affected persons or to reports or</u>		
26	<u>newsletters relating to the prevention or treatment of disease</u>		
27	<u>or injury.</u>		
28	<u>(b) Unsolicited agency e-mails authorized by this</u>		
29	<u>section must contain a provision that allows the recipient to</u>		
30	<u>be removed from future unsolicited agency e-mails upon his or</u>		
31	<u>her e-mail request.</u>
