Subsections (1) and (2) of section 419.001, 11 12 Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 419.001 Site selection of community residential 13 14 homes.--15 (1)As used in For the purposes of this section, the 16 term following definitions shall apply: "Community residential home" means a dwelling unit 17 licensed to serve clients of the Department of Children and 18 19 Family Services, which provides a living environment for 7 to 20 14 unrelated residents who operate as the functional 21 equivalent of a family, including such supervision and care by 22 supportive staff as may be necessary to meet the physical, emotional, and social needs of the residents. 23 "Department" means the Department of Children and 24 (b) 25 Family Services. "Local government" means a county as set forth in 26 27 chapter 7 or a municipality incorporated under the provisions 28 of chapter 165. "Resident" means any of the following: 29 30 elder as defined in s. 400.618; a physically disabled or handicapped person as defined in s. 760.22(7)(a); a

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developmentally disabled person as defined in s. 393.063(12); a nondangerous mentally ill person as defined in s. 394.455(18); or a child as defined in s. 39.01(14), s. 984.03(9) or (12), or s. 985.03(8).

(e) "Sponsoring agency" means an agency or unit of government, a profit or nonprofit agency, or any other person or organization which intends to establish or operate a community residential home.
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(2) Homes of six or fewer residents which otherwise meet the definition of a community residential home shall be deemed a single-family unit and a noncommercial, residential use for the purpose of local laws and ordinances. Homes of six or fewer residents which otherwise meet the definition of a community residential home shall be allowed in single-family or multifamily zoning without approval by the local government; however, provided that such a home must homes shall not be located within a radius of 1,000 feet of another existing such home with six or fewer residents or within a radius of 500 feet of an existing single-family home. Such homes with six or fewer residents need not shall not be required to comply with the notification provisions of this section; provided, however, that the sponsoring agency or the department must notify notifies the local government at the time of home occupancy that the home is licensed by the department.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
