Section 877.135, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 15 877.135 Corrupting or attempting to corrupt student 16 17 athletes.--(1) Whoever gives or offers any inducement to a high 18 19 school or middle school athlete with the intent of encouraging such athlete to attend or not attend a particular academic 20 institution, to become a professional athlete, or to endorse a 21 22 product or commercial establishment commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or by 23 a fine not to exceed the larger of \$1,000 or three times the 24 25 value of the inducement given or offered. Nothing herein shall 26 prohibit the prosecution of such person under any other laws. 27 (2) The provisions of this section shall not apply to 28 the offering of a scholarship by the academic institution or 29 the provision of items and expenses specifically permitted 30 under the rules and regulations governing the recruitment of athletes by the academic institution. 2	professional sports team or organization that has provided the
3	athlete with a written statement outlining any limitations
