20	<u>of work activities, have employees with similar industry</u>		
21	<u>classifications, and confine their work exclusively or</u>		
22	<u>predominately to a horseracing track or facility servicing a</u>		
23	<u>horseracing track in this state may form a group and aggregate</u>		
24	<u>their employer obligations under this chapter so that the</u>		
25	<u>aggregated business activities of 10 or more separate entities</u>		
26	<u>may be considered as single employer for purposes of arranging</u>		
27	<u>workers' compensation insurance or self-insurance</u>
