A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to school personnel; amending  
s. 1002.33, F.S.; requiring charter school  
personnel to be subject to state and federal  
rules and regulations that govern public school  
personnel; creating s. 1012.47, F.S.; requiring  
certain personnel in an alternative school that  
operates under contract with a district school  
system to file a set of fingerprints; requiring  
personnel to be subject to state and federal  
rules and regulations; providing an effective  
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (12) of section  
1002.33, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.33 Charter schools.--

(12) EMPLOYEES OF CHARTER SCHOOLS.--

(a) A charter school shall select its own employees. A  
charter school may contract with its sponsor for the services  
of personnel employed by the sponsor. Charter school personnel  
shall be subject to state and federal rules and regulations  
that govern public school personnel.

Section 2. Section 1012.47, Florida Statutes, is  
created to read:

1012.47 Employment of alternative school  
personnel.--All instructional and noninstructional personnel  
who are hired to fill positions requiring direct contact with  
students in an alternative school that operates under contract  
with a district school system shall, upon employment and

1 according to conditions of the contract, file a complete set  
2 of fingerprints as required in s. 1012.32. Such personnel  
3 shall be subject to state and federal rules and regulations  
4 that govern public school personnel.

5           Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
