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Representative Ryan offered the following:

**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove everything after the enacting clause, and insert:

Section 1. A task force is created to study and report on the feasibility and efficiency of combining the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability and the Office of the Auditor General into an Office of Government Accountability. Members of the task force shall include three members of the House of Representatives, three members of the Senate, and the Auditor General as an ex officio member. The minority leaders of the House of Representatives and the Senate shall each appoint one member to the task force. The study shall include a cost analysis, a report on the feasibility of combining auditing and policy analysis within a single office, and a plan specifying costs that are currently duplicated or unnecessary. A final report shall be submitted to the Speaker of

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28 the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate by  
29 February 29, 2004.

30 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
