Such administrative processing fee shall be 23 deposited in the department's Operating Trust Fund and shall be used to offset the cost of the department's services. The 24 25 department may also deposit or transfer into the General 26 Revenue Fund offender overpayments that are less than \$10 at 27 the end of the offender's supervision; offender funds that are 28 not claimed within 1 year after supervision is terminated; 29 victim restitution payments that are not claimed within 1 year 30 after the offender's supervision is terminated to the General Revenue Fund to fund victim programs or the automated victim 31 1
