**Senate Amendment**

On page 2, lines 4-14, delete those lines

and insert: any business operating jointly with the library  
may, only for the purpose of collecting fines or recovering  
overdue books, documents, films, or other items or materials  
owned or otherwise belonging to the library, disclose, from  
disclosing information made confidential and exempt by this  
section to the following:

1. The library patron named in the records;

2. In the case of a library patron less than 16 years  
of age, the parent or guardian of that patron named in the  
records;

3. Any entity that collects fines on behalf of a  
library, unless the patron is less than 16 years of age, in  
which case only information identifying the patron's parent or  
guardian may be released;

4. Municipal or county law enforcement officials,  
unless the patron is 16 years of age, in which case only
