Between lines 328-329, insert:

Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 465.0265, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (5) and a new subsection (4) is added to said section, to read:

465.0265 Centralized prescription filling.--

(4) Pharmacies accessing the same prescription records in a centralized database or pharmacy computers linked in any other manner may refill or dispense prescriptions at the request of another pharmacy so linked, provided that the pharmacies have the same owner or have a written contract specifying the services to be provided by each pharmacy, the responsibilities of each pharmacy, and the manner in which the pharmacies will comply with federal and state laws, rules, and regulations. Prescriptions refilled or dispensed using such a system shall

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28 not be considered prescription transfers or copies provided the
 29 computer system registers a complete and full audit trail of all
 30 activities and includes the identification of the pharmacies and
 31 pharmacists accessing the centralized database, and provided
 32 that the system restricts access to the computerized
 33 prescription records to pharmacies or other authorized
 34 personnel.
