Section 2. Subsection (39) is added to section 18 19 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read: 20 320.08058 Specialty license plates.--(39) U.S. PARATROOPERS LICENSE PLATES.--21 22 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 320.08053, 23 the department shall develop a U.S. Paratroopers license plate as provided in this section. U.S. Paratroopers license plates 24 25 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. 26 The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and 27 the words "U.S. Paratroopers" must appear at the bottom of the 28 plate. The Airborne Wings and Glider Wings logo must appear in 29 black on the left side of the plate, centered from top to 30 bottom. The plate must have a white background with red and blue letters or numbers. 31

7	distributed to the State Homes for Veterans Trust Fund.
8	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
