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A bill to be entitled
An act relating to child care facilities;
amending s. 402.305, F.S.; requiring child care
facilities and private and nonpublic schools
within 10 miles of a nuclear power plant to
develop and maintain emergency evacuation
plans; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (7) of
section 402.305, Florida Statutes, to read:

402.305 Licensing standards; child care facilities.--

(7) SANITATION AND SAFETY.--

(d) Each child care facility or private or nonpublic
school within the 10-mile emergency planning zone of a nuclear
power plant shall establish an emergency management and
emergency preparedness plan. Such plan must include effective
protective actions, transportation resources and routes,
relocation centers, procedures for the receipt and
dissemination of emergency information, and methods for
notifying parents and guardians of the status and location of
their children.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2003.
